The Urinary System

EQ: How does the urinary system work?

<u>Urinary System</u> – filters waste and extra fluid from the blood in the form of urine
- Composed of four parts

Part 1

- Kidneys

- Two bean shaped organs about the size of a fist
- Contain nephrons, which are tiny filtering units
- Monitors and adjusts amount of salts and water in blood

Part 2

- Ureters

Two tubes that carry urine from the kidneys to the bladder

Each is about 8 to 10 inches long

Part 3

- Bladder

Hollow, muscular organ located in the pelvic cavity


Stores urine

Stores about 2 cups comfortably for 2 to 5 hours

- Part 4
 - Urethra

Tube that leads from the bladder to the outside of the body
